CUSTOMS REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION FOR IMPORTS

HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS

Documents Required

- Copy of Passport
- · Detailed inventory, valued and signed in English or Spanish
- Original Change of Residence Certificate (obtained from country of origin)
- Baja Consular (Spanish national)
- Original "Empadronamiento" Certificate (from the Spanish City Hall)
- Foreigner Identification Number (NIE) / Copy of DNI
- Original Bill of Lading (OBL) / Air Waybill (AWB)
- Diplomatic Franchise issued by the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Diplomats)

Specific Information

- Change of Residence Certificate must demonstrate a full year of European Economical Space.
- OBL / AWB
- The shipper must register in the National Tax Office.
- Contact agent for required Customs forms.
- Household goods are duty free if owned and used by shipper for a minimum of 6 months.
- Shipments must be imported into Spain within 12 months after shipper's arrival.

MOTOR VEHICLES

Documents Required

- Registration Certificate (issued in origin country)
- Technical Specification Card
- Purchase Invoice
- Vehicle Title
- OBL

Specific Information

- Cars may be imported duty free if owned and used by shipper for a minimum of 6 months.
- Shipments must be imported into Spain within 12 months after shipper's arrival.
- Car type must be known by Spanish Traffic Authorities.

PETS

Documents Required

- Vaccination Record
- International Veterinary Health Certificate

Specific Information

- Pets should be identified with a microchip or a tattoo.
- Muzzles are required for dogs in some areas of Spain; check with agent for specific locations.

SPAIN - BARCELONA

Pets subject to examination by a Customs veterinarian.

RESTRICTED / DUTIABLE ITEMS

- Arms and ammunition (authorization from the local district police is required)
- · Hunting weapons must be declared on arrival.
- The following items may qualify for free import if within the limits indicated:
 - Cigarettes (200), cigarillos (100 or 3 g each), cigars (50), smoking tobacco (250 g) –
 persons 17 years and older
 - $_{\odot}$ Alcoholic beverages over 22% (1 L) $_{\odot}$ Alcoholic beverages under 22% (2 L) $_{\odot}$ Beer (16 L), wine (4 L)

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- o Items of protected species and products made from them (Washington Convention or CITES).
- π Ivory
- θ Coral
- ρ Reptile skins
- σ Wood from the Amazonian forests

CONSIGNMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Recommended: Contact the destination agent to ensure all requirements have been met prior to import, especially for differences regarding air / sea shipments.
